NOTICE

Mid-Sem Examinations of UG/PG/MCA 2nd semester, 2021

The Mid Semester examinations of UG II Semester will be conducted from 7^{th} – 10^{th} September, 2021 and those of PG/MCA II Semester will be conducted from 6^{th} - 11^{th} September, 2021 by the respective Departments. The format of the Examinations shall be as follows:

- 1) The Mid-Sem examinations shall be conducted under the supervision of the Heads of the respective Departments using question papers as well as home assignments given to students using any of the accessible online means such as Google Classroom, Email through registered mail ID, Whatsapp etc. The students shall submit the completed assignments or answer sheets by the same means.
- 2) Teachers of concerned papers are requested to collaborate with their respective HoDs in preparing the question papers as well as home assignments to be used for the Mid-Sem examination.
- 3) The Mid-Sem examination for theory component of a full paper will carry 30 marks. A total of another 20 marks will be based on continuous evaluation, assignment and practicals (if any) till the end of August 2021. This way, evaluation of UG/ PG/ MCA students will have completed for a total of 50 marks for each full paper.
- 4) The first component (30 marks) shall represent the Online Examination component while the second part (20 marks) will represent Continuous Assessment in the form of assignments. The duration of the Online Mid-Sem Examination of a paper shall be one and a half hour (90 minutes) minutes plus 20 minutes for the upload of scanned answer scripts.
- 5) The question paper for the Online Mid Semester Examination should preferably be descriptive and Open-Book Mode. An option of 3-4 questions may be provided by the respective Departments, each question carrying 15 marks, out of which two (02) questions must be answered. In unavoidable cases, a 15 mark question may be split into two or at most three parts.
- 6) The examiners shall specify word limits for the answers to the questions set.
- 7) The evaluation of the second component (20 marks) may be carried out as per the mutual convenience of the students and concerned faculty. In case the papers are shared by more than one teacher the HoD shall appoint a faculty to coordinate the evaluation process of the specific paper.
- 8) The programme for UG 2nd semester is as follows:

7th September - Paper I(core)

9th September - Paper II(core)

10th September - Elective paper.

- 9) No Mid-Sem examination will be held for papers having credit of 2(two) or less than 2(two) for CBCS (new) courses.
- 10) On completion of the Mid-Sem examinations the students of intermediate even semesters will have been evaluated for 50 out of 100 marks for each full paper. As per UGC guidelines dated 16th July, 2021, the final results of the student will be prepared by calculating grades on the basis of 50% from earlier semester and the rest from the mid semester and internal assessment. Therefore, on completion of the above mentioned Mid-Sem and internal evaluations, the final results will be evaluated.
