



Jamia Milia shines in MCB Debate



Jamia Milia Islamia University swept the Best Team and Best Debator awards in the 38th Manik Chandra Barooah Memorial National Level Debate competition which successfully concluded on September 7, 2019 at the KBR Hall in the University premises. Cotton University won the second best team award. In the individual categories, Syeda Tahera Ahmed of Jamia Milia Islamia University, Nandini Chakravorty of Cotton University and Ivan Baruah of Shyamlal College, Delhi won the first, second and third prizes respectively. This year the topic of the debate was 'In the opinion of the house, the present status of citizenship in India is rooted in the provisions of the constitution which are non-negotiable'. Hon'ble

Justice of Gauhati High Court Justice Ujjal Bhuyan graced the occasion as the chief guest. The debate was led by speaker S. Irfan Habib, a historian and public intellectual. A souvenir was also released on the occasion by All Assam Students Union (AASU) Advisor Dr. Samujjal Bhattacharjya.

Students from Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), Jamia Milia Islamia University, Hindu College, Delhi University, Shyamlal College, Manipur University, National Law University and Judicial Academy Assam, North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Gauhati University, Handique Girls College etc. participated in the competition.

CJI Ranjan Gogoi inaugurates Cotton Alumni House

Chief Justice of India Justice Ranjan Gogoi inaugurated the Cotton Alumni House at Cotton University campus on May 26, 2019. He congratulated Cotton College Alumni Association for its various activities to carry forward the glorious legacy of the revered institution. He also recalled his fond memories of his academic life at Cotton College during the early seventies. While addressing the open session after formally inaugurating the Cotton College Alumni House, CJI Gogoi said that dissent and debate are cornerstones of democratic way of life. He emphasized that these two cornerstones of democracy have been under threat, thereby creating a disturbing situation for the institutions on which democracy stood.

Addressing the younger and present generation of Cottonians, Justice Gogoi said that there is no substitute to hard work to achieve one's goal. He exhorted the younger generation not to be disheartened even during times of injustice. Justice Gogoi also handed over a cheque of Rs 1 lakh as his individual contribution to Cotton College Alumni Association. Chief Justice (Acting) of Gauhati High Court Justice Arup Kumar Goswami, Vice Chancellor Prof.

Bhabesh Chandra Goswami and Secretary of Cotton College Alumni Association Dr. Satyendra Kumar Choudhury also spoke on the occasion. The meeting was presided over by Justice (retd.) D.N. Choudhury. Several former Cottonians, prominent citizens from different walks of life and faculties of Cotton University attended the function.

A commemorative volume of the centenary celebrations of Cotton College (observed during 2001-02) titled *Satabdir Pratibimba* edited by Dr. Satyendra Kumar Choudhury, Jagadish Dutta and Hiranya Kumar Barman was also released at the function. The newly inaugurated Cotton Alumni House has a 1000 square feet (sq ft) conference hall, a 300 sq ft office room and a care taker's room on its ground floor. On its first floor, it has a conference hall measuring 1,400 sq ft and two guest rooms. The Association has kept around 800 sq ft set aside for an IT centre on its second floor.

Cotton organises National Workshop on Gender Equity

As a part of an innovative pan-India initiative towards gender audits in higher education campuses across the country, a unique first-of-its-kind workshop was organised at Cotton University during March 11-14, 2019. The workshop on Gender Equity and Inclusion hosted by Cotton University collaborated with Women in Security, Conflict Management and Peace (WISCOMP), a New Delhi based South Asian initiative that promotes women's equal participation and leadership in security and peace-building. The workshop sought to facilitate and institutionalise gender-just norms, policies and practices in Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) that move beyond campaigns or merely punitive approaches to sexual harassment. This workshop attempted to open up spaces within university spaces for engaged dialogue to promote and nurture inclusion and equity This initiative led by Dr. Meenakshi Gopinath Director, WISCOMP and her team Seema Kakran was supported by the Public Affairs Section of the U.S. Embassy, New Delhi. The workshop was attended by the Registrar, Dean, Students Welfare, Academic Registrar, Coordinator IQAC, faculty and students from Cotton University who committed to collaboratively make their campus gender-just and inclusive by raising awareness, tracking progress and maximizing the reach of gendersensitization processes. Faculty from Ambedkar University, Gauhati University, Jadavpur University, TISS Guwahati, Donbosco University, NESRC and other colleges contributed their expertise to the deliberations.

Eminent Fulbright-Nehru Scholars from the USA, Prof. Yudit Greenberg and Prof. Roseann Mandzuik were joined by women's studies department faculty from Jadavpur University, Ambedkar University and women's rights advocates, and others as speakers and facilitators.

An interesting feature of the workshop was YouthSpeak a mime performance by the Cotton University students that was curated during a three-day parallel theatre workshop. There were installations on gender sensitivity and awareness through pictures and posters on campus that brought the spotlight on the need for gender-just policies and attitudes.

Another unique feature of the workshop was the presentation by the global initiative Safetipin. Dr. Kalpana Viswanath, CEO of Safetipin and her team



conducted a session with the students on the use of Safetipin, a unique and innovative mobile app that measures perceptions of campus safety.

It also proposes to operationalize NAAC mandates that require gender audits, a pilot version of which has recently been conducted by the core team. While Dr. Rakhee Kalita Moral, the coordinator of the project at Cotton University led a NE India panel 'Engendering the Discourse: Perspectives from the Field' at the three-day workshop. Prof. Debojit Sarma, Dean, SW, spoke about glaring gender gaps in the Women in STEM Education panel which also had Dr. Sanjay Dutta, Academic Registar deliberate on discriminatory practices. Dr. Santanu Sarma, Convenor, IQAC laid out the imperatives of gender programmes and trainings as stipulated by UGC. In the student program of this workshop Dr. Dhrubajyoti Das, Dr. Gulshan Parveen and Pallavi Baruah were faculty advisors while Dr. Afsana Barbhuiyan assisted in overseeing the logistics. Dr. Rakhee Kalita Moral, sees in this unique event an opportunity for feminists and educators from the North East to build synergy with national and international scholars and hopes this is the beginning of a transformation among HEIs in the region on gender-inclusive best practices, pioneered by its oldest institution Cotton University.

Cotton celebrates 119th Foundation Day

Cotton celebrated 119 glorious years of its existence with the Foundation Day programme at the University premise on May 27. Former Judge of the Gauhati High Court Justice Biplab Kumar Sharma was invited to deliver the Foundation Day lecture. He deliberated on 'Citizenship Law and Foreigners Issue in Assam'.

While addressing the gathering, Sharma spoke about the history of Assam's struggle for political safeguards and the role of the first Chief Minister of Assam Gopinath Bordoloi in this regard. He quoted specific communication from Bordoloi's letters to the then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru highlighting the issue of infiltration in Assam during that time and its threat to the indigenous people. Justice Sharma also discussed the ramifications of the constitutional provisions of citizenship in the context of foreigners particularly in the case of Assam and called upon the civil society to deliberate upon it.

The lecture was followed by an interactive session. In an answer to a question raised by one of the faculties on the merits and demerits of the Citizenship Amendment Bill (CAB), Justice Sharma said, "In my opinion, CAB will bring no harm to the indigenous people of the State. This is however my personal opinion".

Also present on the occasion were Vice Chancellor of Cotton University Prof. Bhabesh Chandra Goswami, Registrar Prof. Diganta Kumar Das, members of the Executive Council and Academic Council, former and current faculty members, staff and students. The celebration concluded with the felicitation of students and faculty members who have achieved in academics and extra-curricular activities during the academic year.

92nd issue of Cottonian released





National seminar on 'Harnessing Wetlands for Sustainable Livelihood' held

A national seminar on 'Harnessing Wetlands for Sustainable Livelihood' was held during November 26-27, 2018 at Cotton University. It was sponsored by Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of Assam and organised by ASTEC in collaboration with Cotton University. As many as 68 research papers were received of which 58 were presented in the two-day deliberation. Invited speakers of the seminar were Prof. S. K. Patnaik of Rajib Gandhi University, Arunachal Pradesh, Prof. D. C. Goswami of Gauhati University, Dr. Vinay S.P. Sinha of TERI, New Delhi and Dr. Kasturi Chakrabrty, Scientist of NESAC, Meghalaya.

In the inaugural function, Hon'ble Education Minister Sri Siddhartha Bhattacharya, Vice Chancellor of CU, Prof. Bhabesh Chandra Goswami, Director of ASTEC, Dr. Arup Kr. The book contains 25 selected papers and three invited research articles by wetland experts. Dr. Pradip Sharma is the Chief Editor, and Dr. Jaideep Baruah, Dr. Dhanjit Deka and Prachuryya Kaushik are the editors of the book.

Activities under UBA

₩ Cotton University has been selected as one of the beneficiaries of the Unnat Bharat Λbhiyan (UBA), which is an initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India with an aim to bring transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an inclusive India. Under this programme, five villages namely Keotpara, Nij Panbari, Hajongbori, Kalitapara and Satargaon have been adopted by the University since 2018, the last two villages being adopted in June, 2019.


If As per requirements, village and household-level surveys of four villages – Keotpara, Nij Panbari Hajongbori and Satargaon have been completed and the data have been uploaded in the reporting portal of the UBA. Swacchata Awareness Campaign was carried out simultaneously in the villages by the field investigators (students of Cotton University).

Gram Sabhas were organised in Hajongbori, Keotpara and Nijpanbari during 2018 and in the two new villages Kalitapara and Satargaon on 11 June 2019 and 18 June 2019 respectively. The main purpose of these programmes was to make the villagers aware of the Unnat Bharat Mission of the Govt of India, the involvement of Cotton University. A day long outreach workshop on the DBT Foldscope was also organised at Panbari High School, Nijpanbari Village in November, 2018.

R A two-day programme on Oyster Mushroom Cultivation awareness and training was held during April 6-7, 2019 in the Keotpara Lower Primary School premises in the village Keotpara. The programme is the first of the many upcoming community workshops with an ultimate goal of providing alternate livelihood options to the people living near Deepor Beel. The training was conducted by a team of experts from Department of Biotechnology, Bodoland University, Kokrajhar. Over 30 participants, irrespective of age and gender, received knowledge on edible mushrooms, its food value and increasing demand with hands on training on cultivation process, storage and marketing of mushroom.
