Professor Steven E Lindow is currently serving as Professor Emeritus at the Department of Plant and Microbial Biology, University of California Berkeley. He has researched the application of transgenic bacteria to prevent frost damage in crops as well as using bacteria to prevent the russeting of fruits. He is a member of several scientific societies, including the National Academy of Sciences. His work is geared towards a better understanding of plant colonists with a view to development of biological strategies for plant disease and frost control.
